FROM TENMILE LAKE COUNTY PARK, ALONG PARK AVENUE, TO SOUTH 8TH STREET. FROM 8TH STREET TO AIRPORT WAY AND FROM AIRPORT WAY TO SPINREEL ROAD, WITH THE FINAL DESTINATION AT SPINREEL DUNE ACCESS.

HOURS 8:00 AM to Dusk (30 Min. after sunset).



ORDINANCE 20-293
LAKESIDE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES SPINREEL
DUNES ACCESS ROUTE

Liability. The Operation of an ATV will be undertaken at the sole risk and responsibility of the owner and/or operator. The City, by passing this Ordinance assumes no responsibility for the operation of such ATV's and will be held harmless in any action arising from the operation of such ATV's on or off any public

way within the City, including without limitation, Streets.

Regulations

- **1.** Must have a valid Driver License/Driving Privileges.
- **2.** Hold an Oregon ATV Safety Education Card.
- 4. Must have an Oregon ATV Permit.
- **3.** Liability Insurance under ORS 806-010 must cover Operator and ATV.
- 4. Remain on Route and roads. <u>Do Not</u>

 Drive on the Shoulders of the Road!
- 5. Follow Posted Traffic Signs and Laws.
- **6.** Proper Hand Signals will be used if turn indicators are not installed on ATV.
- **7.** Do not drive carelessly, aggressively or speed as to endanger others or property.
- **8**. It is unlawful to operate an ATV under the influence of alcohol or any other controlled substance.

It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly permit, allow or encourage the operation or driving of an ATV by a person under the age of 16.

Equipment

No ATV shall be operated within the City unless it is equipped with the following:

A) A muffler in good working order not to exceed applicable standards established by DEQ as stated in ORS 821.210.

B) A headlamp, white in color for increased visibility from the front.

- **C)** Tail lamp, red in color and plainly visible from 250 feet to the rear.
- **D)** Class II and Class IV will be equipped with a functioning rear-view mirror.
- **E)** Class II and Class IV ATV's will be equipped with safety belts for the operator and each passenger.
- **G)** ATV operators shall wear at a minimum of a Helmet and Eye protection, with the exception of Class II & IV ATVs. However all youth 16 and below are required to wear a helmet on all ATVs.
